- Aby Warburg, 'A Lecture on Serpent Ritual' (1923, translated by W.F. Mainland in 1939) Warburg died suddenly, leaving his last project unfinished: an 'image atlas', arranged on 40 screens, which he titled Mnemosyne, after the Greek goddess of memory. Designed to serve as a storyboard or mnemonic device, it was the culmination of 40 years of his intellectual development and, to this day, remains as enigmatic as it was upon his death

in 1929.
