The idea of chord construction can be simply broken down into 3 main groups of sound (and one small "odd-ball" group). Each of the 3 main groups has its own subdivisions and the groups are based on one basic chord type each, namely: 1) The MAJORchord 2) The MINORchord 3) The DOMINANT 7thchord

Chord Construction (Formulas) - Ted Greene

Chords are built in 3rds from the major scale. So a Major chord is built by stacking the notes of the major scale in 3rds (C Major = C E G B D F A). Since we run out of notes if we only stack within one octave, we use a two octave scale. This is why you will see numbers associated with some chords over 7 (there are 7 notes in the scale).

Minor chords, or minor triads are constructed the same way, the difference is the minor sound, which is always a flat third degree note in minor triads: Minor Chord = I - b III - V degree notes So minor chords are the root note, a flattened third note (1 semitone below the regular 3rd degree) and the fifth note of the major scale.

The easiest way to wrap your head around chord construction is learn it in relation to a scale. Chords are built from scale degrees by stacking other scale tones of certain intervals apart. To be considered a chord you need at least three different tones. The most basic chord is called the triad(which means consisting of three).

Major Chord Construction To get started, we begin with a scale we all know, the C major scale. The 7 notes in this scale are numbered, these numbers are important (they are like a formula). Chords are based on third intervals.

Jazz Guitar Chord Theory - How To Construct Jazz Chords?

The basic chord consists of 3 different notes chosen in the triad section, the formula is to stack the degrees upwards while always skipping one, so we get 1 - 3 - 5 as the base for our triad (commonly referred as stacked thirds). The only exception to this formula is when we 'suspend' the 3rd degree to an adjacent degree.
