Locate and put your finger on the starter relay, and have someone turn the key. You should hear and feel a distinct "click" when the key is turned to the "Start" position. If there is no click, swap the starter relay with another one, such as the fuel pump relay. Replace the relay if the starter engages.

### How to Diagnose and Replace a Starter

Starter doesn't function when turning the key. In some cases, the first symptom of a starter malfunction is a complete failure of the starter motor. This happens when you turn the ignition key to start the car, the starter motor does not function at all.

Remove the bolts that secure the starter to the engine block with a wrench and then pull the starter away from the block. In some cases, you will see a set of shims mounted between the starter and the engine block. Keep the shims and transfer them to the new starter. Step 7

Get under the truck and locate the starter on the the passenger side of the engine block's lower side, towards the transmission bell housing. You can also trace the red cable going from the battery to the starter to find it. Locate the electrical connections on the top of the starter (usually two or three).

Remove the lock nuts from the bolts holding the starter in position. Most Mercruiser starters have bolts that will run from the bottom to the top, rather than from side to side like on a car starter. Once the nuts are off, reach underneath and pull the bolts out.

Installing the New Starter Set the starter motor in place on the power head. Thread the retaining bolts through the mounting bracket and tighten securely. Attach the grounding cable you disconnected from the old starter -- but tagged and left in place -- if the starter motor requires a separate ground cable.

Position the new starter motor on the engine and attach it with the right mounting bolt. Position the wire retainer and the left bolt and then route the wires through the retainer. Install and tighten the left mounting bolt. Attach the starter motor wire and connect it with the mounting nut.

Slide the new starter into position. Insert the bottom bolt, just get it started. Insert the upper bolt, just get it started. Hand tighten the lower, then the upper; make sure they are tight, but there is no torque spec needed.

Get the new starter and plug it into the motor using the sockets and wrench. Then, fix back the intake and hoses in the order of how each part was removed but in reverse order. Lastly, plug back the negative terminal.
